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### **IB Course Application Package**

Parkland is a public school located in School District #63 in Sidney-North Saanich and welcomes all students in its catchment area. North Saanich Middle School (grades 6-8) is the feeder school to Parkland and is located less than a kilometer away.

Students who do not currently live in the Parkland catchment area and are interested in attending Parkland must complete admissions paperwork and an Out of Area form and have the principal of their catchment school sign the form. Once this paperwork is complete, families are asked to make an appointment with Parkland vice principal for an interview. Parkland will accept all students providing it has the space.

#### **IB** admissions:

Parkland is proud to be able to offer the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program for students in their final two years of high school. This optional program is academically rigorous and designed to develop the whole person. Students who are planning on attending University are strongly encouraged to consider this academic pathway.

Students taking the full International Baccalaureate Diploma Program will take six IB courses in addition to CAS (Creativity, Action, Service), EE (Extended Essay) and TOK (Theory of Knowledge).

Students can also elect to take individual IB courses rather than the full complement of 6 courses. These students are considered Certificate students and would be taking a combination of IB courses and BC high school courses.

At Parkland we encourage all students to challenge themselves. The IB program is appropriate for students who:

- have maintained at minimum a B average
- have strong work habits and study skills
- are able to manage their time effectively
- care about their local and global community
- are prepared to persevere and strive to do their best

The IB program is intended to be attainable for most students. It is not an exclusive program however there is an application process in place in order to ensure that the IB program is a good fit for prospective students.

The IB is an internationally recognized program with an extensive infrastructure and as such has fees associated with its programs. The following is the fee structure applicable to Parkland's IB program for students beginning the program in September 2024.

#### **IB Diploma Program fee structure:**

#### **IB Course Program fee structure:**

Registration fee	Due April 30, 2024	\$250**
Year 1 fee	Due September 15, 2024	\$150 per course or \$500 (whichever is less)
Year 2 fee	Due September 15, 2025	\$150 per course or \$500 (whichever is less)

School District #63 recognizes that the payment of fees is a hardship for some families. Families are encouraged to make decisions about application to programs based on educational reasons, not financial ones. No student will be denied participation in any program due to the inability to pay the associated fees. Payment plans and fee reductions may be possible.

\*\* 250 is a non refundable deposit. Upon graduation from the IB program, this registration fee will be reimbursed to the family.
